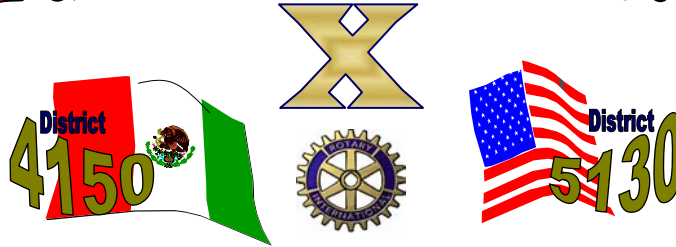


Festival of Brotherhood



Fellow Rotarians and family members, it is that time again to sign up for our

10TH ANNUAL FESTIVAL OF BROTHERHOOD IN GUADALAJARA & PUERTO VALLARTA, MEXICO NOVEMBER 4-13, 2005.

THE FESTIVAL IS . . .

- An opportunity to become acquainted with Rotarians from many clubs in Mexico while reviewing and visiting potential projects first hand.
- A special time for all Rotarians to become involved with World Community Service projects. By visiting schools, orphanages and medical clinics, Rotarians gain new perspective on how Rotary can make a difference in the lives of many.

WE WILL . . .

- Depart Friday, November 4 for the flight to Guadalajara Airport
- Take a comfortable bus to Puerto Vallarta for 4 relaxing days/nights
- Travel north to Tepic for one night
- Then go to Guadalajara. for the final 4 nights
- Enjoy luxury hotel accommodations.
- Be hosted and shown around by local Rotarians
- Return on Sunday, November 13 into San Francisco International Airport.

An additional feature for this year: A second group may attend the **activities in Guadalajara only.** This group departs from Oakland on Wednesday, November 9, returning Sunday, November 13. This second group will participate in the formal activities of the Festival of Brotherhood in Guadalajara. There will also be ample time to sight see and enjoy Mexico as guests of local Rotarians.

COST

The following costs are approximations at this time:

- Round trip airfare to Guadalajara from San Francisco: \$580.
- Hotel accommodations for 9 nights in quality hotels in all 3 cities: \$450 per person, dbl. occupancy; single supplement applies.
- Ground transportation, and various meals not hosted: an additional \$250.
- **Total cost for air, hotels, transportation and meals is estimated at about \$1280.**
- For those going only to Guadalajara, the cost is estimated at about \$880.

REGISTRATION

- Please fill out an application and submit a \$100 per person deposit by **June 15, 2005** in order to hold your hotel reservation and flight. **The balance is due September 1, 2005.**
- Travel arrangements are being made at HMS Travel at (707) 526-2922 with Tommi Holt as our travel agent. Please arrange any modifications to the flight schedule with Tommi.
