Program: Turning a temporary project into a ongoing project

It takes a lot of energy to get a temporary Rotary project going, and it is often a challenge to institutionalize it and make it more of a permanent fixture. The program will discuss ideas on how this can be done, including aligning with other non-Rotary organizations, and having some non-volunteer resources to tackle some of the administrative work. Also it is important to stay in touch with the fundamental need that is being served by the project.

In February 2004 Santa Rosa Sunrise Rotary launched a Dental Outreach Program in cooperation with Santa Rosa Junior College (SRJC) to benefit those who cannot access dental care. The program is a Rotary International Centennial Project. Since that time over 300 children have been served in an ongoing program that has served elementary schools in Guerneville, Monte Rio, Windsor, Santa Rosa, and Bodega Bay. This temporary project is now developing a sustaining life of its own that we hope will enable it to continue for many years to come.
