

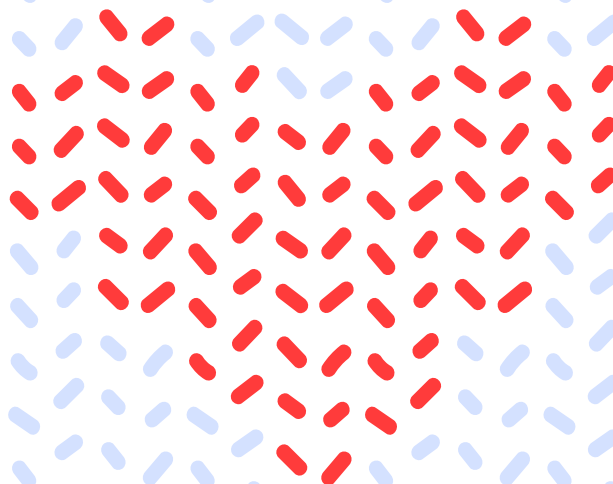
Earlyact
