

DISTRICT 5130 YOUTH SERVICE CHAIRPERSON

ROLE:

To serve as the District liaison, overseeing the Youth Service Team that assists and trains Rotary Club members in the identification, prioritization, planning, implementation and evaluation of Youth Service programs and projects.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

To recruit and develop compelling speakers and to facilitate the Youth Training component at the District Training Assembly and District Conference.

To facilitate the Youth Service Team, which supports the functions of individual Rotary Clubs in implementing specific projects, falling under:

- General Youth Service
- Interact
- Rotaract
- RYLA
- Youth Protection
- Youth Exchange

To become familiar with model service projects being conducted within the District and identify Rotarians who could serve as mentors for other clubs.

To assist Club Youth Service Chairs as requested, in their training, program logistics and problem solving efforts as needed.

To assist at other District/Club activities, including events and meetings as needed or requested by the District Governor.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Be a member in good standing of a Rotary Club for at least two years. Have led/organized/participated in various service projects involving youth. Having served as a Youth Services Chair of your club is preferred. Having been a Youth Exchange Host Parent or Youth Exchange Counselor (inbound or outbound) a plus.

TERM OF OFFICE:

Two years - at the discretion of the standing District Governor.
