


• Where does the money come from?





DONATIONS TO THE FOUNDATION COME BACK TO US

Example: D5130 donates \$400,000 to the Annual Fund



DISTRICT GRANTS – WHAT ARE THEY?

- Small-scale, short-term
- Local or international activities
- Alignment with the Foundation's mission
- Up to two per club awarded annually





DISTRICT GRANTS - LET'S TALK FREE MONEY....

• <u>2023 – 24 Rotary year</u> –

District Grants up to \$3,000 per Club Environmental Grants up to \$600 per Club

• <u>2024 – 25 Rotary year</u> –

District Grants up to \$2,200 per Club

No Environmental Grants

• Can be used to fund up to 2 projects per Club



STEPS IN THE DISTRICT GRANT PROCESS

- Club President & Grant Contact complete qualification process <u>annually</u>
- Club designs a project and submits District Grant application
- Once approval is received, Club completes project
- Club submits final report
- Final report is accepted and reimbursement check issued to the Club

DISTRICT GRANT IMPORTANT DATES

Important dates

- Club qualification completed by **5/31/2024**
- District Grant Application submitted by 8/1/2024
- Work can NOT begin until approval is received
- Final report submitted by 5/31/2025 or 60 days after project completion

- Step 1: Get your Club qualified for 2024 25 NOW

- How Read Overview, Take Quiz, Sign MOU

TIPS FOR SUCCESS (& FEWER HEADACHES)

- Create Grant application and final reports on word processing software first
- Communicate with partners who does what by when
- Stay on top of the FormSmart submission process
- Plan your project for completion and for your final report – keep invoices, copies of checks; take photos



KEY POINTS FOR DISTRICT GRANTS

Remember, Grant projects MUST

- Include active Rotarian participation
- Adhere to stewardship guidelines
- Demonstrate cultural sensitivity
- Align with the Foundation's mission
